So many people died during this second wave.
- The poor & the needy were the ones who got affected by this deadly virus in various villages of Bihar, families lost their loved ones, people lost their jobs, Children can't go to school because of lockdown, and the ongoing pandemic
- In Bihar with the help of The Lok Manch and MAIN
 (Migrant Assistance & Information Network) in
 collaboration with The Indian Social Institute, New
 Delhi covid relief distribution was done at
 Barachatty block in Gaya district, Danapur,
 Phulwari and Bihitta blocks in Patna. In each of
 these districts, the state coordinators and
 volunteers were able to give dry ration kits to 96
 families and medical kits to 40 people each. The
 relief materials consist of a Home essential kit
 (food and groceries), Wellness Kit (Health
 Supplements), Medicines (Non-prescriptive), IEC
 materials, screening equipment, etc.
